



Welcome to your FTP folder

GENERAL INFO

It is also known as an FTP folder. FTP (Files Transfer Protocol). This Folder and it's files are User/Password protected. Treat this directory as your "My Documents" on the web.

PATH - Addressing

To address files in this folder, it works much like your Computer and it's contents. Such as the C:\ drive of your computer, or your My Documents folder in it like C:\MyDocuments. To address it on the web, you would use:

<http://www.DomainName/files>

Right now there is a starter file called, "Welcome.pdf", in your FTP folder. To link to it or any other file in your FTP you should address it like this:

<http://www.DomainName/files/welcome.pdf>

Files you upload to this folder can be viewed on the web by directing/linking the visitors browser to:

<http://www.DomainName/files/yourfilename.extension>

Used with Domain Name examples: YourDomain.com/files/welcome.pdf, YourDomain.net/files/welcome.pdf, websagogo.com/files/welcome.pdf

File name extension examples: file.html, file.htm, file.pdf, file.asp, etc.

Your FTP folder is a directory located on the root of your website directory called "files". When linking to and referenceing your ftp folder or files in it, you can substitutes your website address with a "/" ". This is a relative path reference and make it easier to create links to files in your website from within your website. See example:

<http://www.YourDomain.com/files/welcome.pdf> becomes.. </files/welcome.pdf> . Thus all path references for "in - site" linking etc. can be "/files/your stuff".

ACCESS

To access your FTP: Open an Internet Browser session (Explorer, Firefox, etc) >> Then, in the address bar at top enter the following:

<http://65.5.0.18:8021>

You will then see a login screen to enter your credentials.
